A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that unsafe driving 2 conditions may occur on two-lane roadways when the lead vehicle 3 is moving slowly, causing a back-up of vehicles behind the lead 4 vehicle, and traffic moving in the opposite direction makes 5 passing vehicles unsafe. For example, this situation is 6 frequently encountered on Hana highway, between mile markers 00 7 and 34, where visibility around turns is limited by natural 8 contours of the road. 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to promote traffic 10 safety on two-lane roadways by requiring drivers of lead 11 vehicles on two-lane roadways to allow vehicles to pass under 12 certain circumstances. 13 Section 291C-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended to read as follows: 15 "[+] §291C-41[+] Drive on right side of roadway;

exceptions. (a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a

- 1 vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the roadway,
- 2 except as follows:
- When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing [such] the movement;
- When an obstruction exists making it necessary to

 drive to the left of the center of the highway;

 provided any person so doing shall yield the right-ofway to all vehicles traveling in the proper direction

 upon the unobstructed portion of the highway within

 [such] the distance [as to constitute] constituting an

 immediate hazard;
- 13 (3) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes for 14 traffic under the rules applicable thereon; or
- (4) Upon a roadway designated and signposted one-waytraffic.
- (b) Upon all roadways any vehicle proceeding at less than
 the normal speed of traffic at the time and place and under the
 conditions then existing shall be driven in the right-hand lane
 then available for traffic, or as close as practicable to the
 right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except when overtaking

- 1 and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or
- 2 when preparing for a left turn at an intersection or into a
- 3 private road or driveway.
- 4 (c) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving
- 5 traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, no
- 6 vehicle shall be driven to the left of the center line of the
- 7 roadway, except when authorized by official traffic-control
- 8 devices designating certain lanes to the left side of the center
- 9 of the roadway for use by traffic not otherwise permitted to use
- 10 [such] the lanes, or except as permitted under subsection
- 11 (a)(2). This subsection shall not be construed to prohibit the
- 12 crossing of the center line in making a left turn into or from
- 13 an alley, private road, or driveway.
- 14 (d) Upon any two-lane roadway providing for two-way
- 15 movement of traffic, any vehicle proceeding at less than the
- 16 speed limit where passing or overtaking another vehicle is not
- 17 possible or permitted, and a line of five or more vehicles is
- 18 following immediately behind, shall move off the roadway at the
- 19 nearest location where sufficient space exists for trailing
- 20 vehicles to overtake."

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Requires vehicles going less than the speed limit on a two-lane highway, behind which a certain number of vehicles are formed in a line, to pull over where possible to let the trailing vehicles proceed when passing is unsafe. Effective 7/1/2050. (HD1)
