BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 328J-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

3 "[+] \$328J-15[+] County ordinances. (a) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to supersede or in any manner affect 4 a county smoking ordinance [+] or the authority of any county to 5 6 adopt and enforce additional ordinances or rules that regulate the sale of cigarettes, tobacco products, or electronic smoking 7 devices; provided that the ordinance or rule is at least as 8 9 protective of the rights of nonsmokers as this chapter. 10 (b) Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit a county from enacting ordinances or rules more stringent than this chapter." 11 SECTION 2. Section 328J-11.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 13 repealed.

14 ["[\$328J-11.5] Statewide concern. (a) Sales of
15 cigarettes, tobacco products, and electronic smoking devices are
16 a statewide concern. It is the intent of the legislature to
