## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF PROPERTY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 4 and to read:
- 5 ""Intellectual property" means intangible property rights
- 6 in the creative products of human intelligence, as protected
- 7 under copyright, patent, trademark, and trade secret laws."
- 8 2. By amending the definition of "property" to read:
- 9 ""Property" means any money, personal property, real
- 10 property, thing in action, evidence of debt or contract, or
- 11 article of value of any kind [-], and includes intellectual
- 12 property and property that is stored in an electronic medium and
- 13 is retrievable in a perceivable form. Commodities of a public
- 14 utility nature such as gas, electricity, steam, and water
- 15 constitute property, but the supplying of such a commodity to
- 16 premises from an outside source by means of wires, pipes,

- 1 conduits, or other equipment shall be deemed a rendition of a
- 2 service rather than a sale or delivery of property."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
