A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The liability protections afforded to 2 lifeguards in Act 170, Session Laws of Hawaii 2002, as amended ("Act 170"), were repealed on June 30, 2017. Act 170 provided 3 liability protection for lifeguard services on the beach or in 4 5 the ocean, except for gross negligence or wanton acts or 6 omissions. This limited liability protection was made necessary 7 because some counties would not provide lifeguard services at 8 state beach parks due to concerns about liability. The legislature finds that Act 170 created a climate in which 9 10 lifeguard services could be provided by the counties without 11 fear of liability and, therefore, was a life-saving measure that 12 should be reestablished.

13 The purpose of this Act is to permanently reinstate the
14 liability protections previously afforded for lifeguard
15 services.

1	SECTION 2. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§663- Exception to liability for county lifeguard
5	services. (a) For the purpose of this section:
6	"County lifeguard" means a person employed as a lifeguard
7	by a county of this State.
8	"Employing county" means the county employing a county
9	lifeguard.
10	(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, neither
11	a county lifeguard, nor the employing county, nor the State
12	shall be liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or
13	omission of the lifeguard while providing rescue, resuscitative,
14	or other lifeguard services on the beach or in the ocean in the
15	scope of employment as a county lifeguard; provided that this
16	exception from liability shall not apply when the claim for
17	civil damages arises from a county lifeguard's alleged gross
18	negligence or wanton act or omission."
19	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
20	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
21	begun before its effective date.
