## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) The following positions are established		
2	within the department of agriculture's agricultural resource		
3	management division:		
4	(1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) irrigation district		
5	manager position (SR21);		
6	(2) Three full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) irrigation system		
7	worker II positions (BC07); and		
8	(3) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) office assistant		
9	III position (SR08).		
10	(b) All rights, powers, functions, and duties relating to		
11	the operational functions of the portions of the east Kauai		
12	irrigation system operated and maintained by the east Kauai		
13	water users' cooperative as of July 1, 2019, shall be		
14	transferred to the department of agriculture until the adoption		
15	of rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
16	completed or until the chairperson of the board of agriculture		
17	determines that the system can be appropriately operated and		



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maintained pursuant to chapters 167 and 168, Hawaii Revised
 Statutes.

3 (c) Until the system is transferred to the appropriate
4 program, acreage assessment and water delivery fees shall not be
5 governed by chapter 167 or 168, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The
6 department of agriculture may contract with the east Kauai water
7 users' cooperative to bill and collect any fees and to enter
8 into any contracts necessary to operate and maintain the system
9 while positions are filled.

10 (d) The department of agriculture shall deposit into the 11 State's general fund all fees collected by the east Kauai water 12 users' cooperative pursuant to subsection (c).

13 The three-year deadline given by the department of (e) 14 land and natural resources to the east Kauai water users' 15 cooperative to obtain a streams diversion works permit may be 16 extended for no more than two years, until July 1, 2021; 17 provided that the applicant demonstrates significant progress in 18 the permit application process. For purposes of this 19 subsection, "significant progress" means that the applicant, at minimum, has submitted a completed stream diversion works permit 20

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application to the department of land and natural resources'
 commission on water resource management.

3 SECTION 2. All appropriations, records, equipment,
4 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents,
5 maps, and other property heretofore made, used, acquired, or
6 held by the east Kauai water users' cooperative relating to the
7 functions transferred to the department of agriculture shall be
8 transferred with the functions to which they relate and listed
9 and described in a full accounting to the department.

10 SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue 11 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much 12 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2019-2020 14 for the purpose of assisting the agricultural resource 15 management division with plans, designs, land acquisition, and 16 equipment to increase state irrigation system capacity 17 statewide, including: 18 (1) for planning; \$

**19** (2) \$ for design;

20 (3) \$ for land acquisition; and

21 (4) \$ for equipment.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 2 agriculture for the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at 4 5 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is 6 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation 7 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date. 8 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of S or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the 11 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 12 2020-2021 for the operations and maintenance of the east Kauai 13 irrigation system, including the following agricultural resource 14 management division staff salaries: 15 (1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) irrigation district 16 manager position (SR21) established pursuant to this 17 Act; 18 (2) Three full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) irrigation system 19 worker II positions (BC07) established pursuant to 20 this Act; '



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1	(3)	One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) office assistant
2		III position (SR08) established pursuant to this Act;
3	(4)	Fifty per cent of the funding for the engineering
4		program manager position (EM07-PN: 40998), which shall
5		be transferred from the non-agricultural park lands
6		special fund to the general fund; and
7	. (5)	Fifty per cent of the funding for the agricultural
8		lands program manager position (EM05-PN: 122475),
9		which shall be transferred from the agricultural park
10		special fund to the general fund.
11	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
12	of agricu	lture for the purposes of this Act.
13	SECT	ION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
