A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that current high
2	school graduates and non-graduates would benefit from aligning
3	educational curriculum to a workforce readiness preparation
4	program. This alignment depends upon close collaboration
5	between the department of education adult community schools
6	and high schools, community colleges, workforce development
7	council, and employers. A workforce readiness program would
8	ensure that students learn skills and earn credentials
9	required for employment by industry after graduation or
10	completion of the community school for adults workforce
11	preparation program.
12	The legislature further finds that collaboration between
13	educators and industry employers will enable students to earn
14	a community school for adults workforce development diploma
15	credential. Students may also earn pre-apprenticeship
16	certificates and other certificates recognized by industry,
17	in addition to an associate degree.
