RELATING TO CIVIL IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Application for the identification card shall be made
- 4 in person by any adult or minor. [The minimum age for minors to
- 5 obtain an identification card shall be ten years of age.] In
- 6 the case of a minor under the age of fourteen years, the
- 7 application shall be made on the minor's behalf by the parent,
- 8 or by another individual in loco parentis of the minor who can
- 9 provide proof of guardianship. In the case of an incompetent
- 10 individual, the application shall be made by the individual
- 11 having the custody or control of or maintaining the incompetent
- 12 individual. A non-compliant identification card shall be issued
- 13 in accordance with section 286-301.5 for applications not made
- 14 in person."
- 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken.
