#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-420, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§302A-420 Profits to pupils. All net profits arising
- 4 from agricultural [and], industrial, or commercial enterprise
- 5 pursuits [under sections 302A-420 to 302A-431] at any school,
- 6 under the rules of the department:
- 7 (1) Shall be used by the school for the purchase of
- 8 equipment and material, not otherwise provided for in
- 9 the school budget, that will be of general benefit to
- 10 the pupils; or
- 11 (2) May be distributed among the pupils actually engaged
- in the pursuits.
- 13 The department shall provide for the keeping of simple books of
- 14 account, showing the source and distribution of the money
- 15 resulting from the operations carried on pursuant to this
- 16 section, and for the auditing of these books of account at least
- 17 quarterly."

- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
