## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-420, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§302A-420 Profits to [pupils.] and school credit for
- 4 <u>students.</u> All net profits arising from agricultural [and],
- 5 industrial, or commercial enterprise pursuits [under sections
- 6 302A-420-to 302A-431] at any school, under the rules of the
- 7 department:
- 8 (1) Shall be used by the school for the purchase of
- 9 equipment and material, not otherwise provided for in
- the school budget, that will be of general benefit to
- 11 the pupils; or
- 12 (2) May be distributed among the [pupils] students
- actually engaged in the pursuits [-]; provided that
- school credit may also be granted to students engaged
- in the permitted operations.
- 16 The department shall provide for the keeping of simple books of
- 17 account, showing the source and distribution of the money

- 1 resulting from the operations carried on pursuant to this
- 2 section, and for the auditing of these books of account at least
- 3 quarterly."
- 4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
