BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 352D-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending its title and subsection (a) to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 "[+] §352D-11[+] Youth commission[-]; youth commission
- 5 administrator. (a) There is established within the office of
- 6 youth services, for administrative purposes only, a youth
- 7 commission to advise the governor and legislature on the effects
- 8 of legislative policies, needs, assessments, priorities,
- 9 programs, and budgets concerning the youth of the State. The
- 10 youth commission shall be administered by the youth commission
- 11 administrator."
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$81,416 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 16 2020-2021 to fund one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) permanent
- 17 youth commission administrator position to administer the youth

- 1 commission and for other associated administrative costs of the
- 2 position. The funding for this position shall be a fixed cost
- 3 in the base budget of the Department of Human Services.
- 4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 5 youth services for the purposes of this Act.

- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
