## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HEALTHY AGING PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii healthy
- 2 aging partnership program was established in 2003 to improve the
- 3 health status of older adults by empowering residents to make
- 4 healthy decisions and engage in healthier lifestyles. Since its
- 5 formation, the healthy aging partnership program has
- 6 successfully adapted evidence-based health promotion programs
- 7 and disease prevention programs for the multicultural population
- ${f 8}$  in Hawaii. Participants may engage in two evidenced-based
- 9 interventions. First, the ke ola pono disease self-management
- 10 programs include several evidence-based programs in which
- 11 individuals with chronic or ongoing medical conditions can learn
- 12 how to effectively manage their health conditions to improve
- 13 their quality of life. The second intervention is
- 14 EnhanceFitness, which is an effective, research-driven exercise
- 15 program to improve the overall functional fitness and well-being
- 16 of older adults. Due to the many accomplishments of the healthy
- 17 aging partnership program, the program received the 2013



- 1 multicultural aging award from the American Society on Aging.
- 2 This accomplishment brought further recognition to the program's
- 3 role in improving the health of Hawaii's diverse aging
- 4 population.
- 5 The legislature finds that the healthy aging partnership
- 6 program received funding for fiscal year 2017-2018 through Act
- 7 103, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017. The program did not receive
- 8 funding for fiscal year 2018-2019 but received funding for
- 9 fiscal year 2019-2020 through Act 124, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 10 2019. Without continued funding, the program will have to close
- 11 and the executive office on aging will not be able to meet the
- 12 first goal of the Hawaii state plan on aging, which strives to
- 13 maximize opportunities for older adults to age well, remain
- 14 active, and enjoy life in their communities.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 16 healthy aging partnership program to further the program's
- 17 important role in improving the health and well-being of
- 18 Hawaii's kupuna.
- 19 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 21 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for

- 1 the healthy aging partnership program to further the program's
- 2 important role in improving the health and well-being of
- 3 Hawaii's kupuna.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 5 office on aging of the department of health for the purposes of
- 6 this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on December 31,
- 8 2059.
