### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that invasive species can 2 wreak havoc on Hawaii's fragile ecosystem, environment, and 3 agricultural lands. The legislature further finds that 4 intrastate commerce and the inter-island transportation of 5 plants has resulted in a significant and growing problem in the 6 county of Maui with: 7 Eleutherodactylus coqui, commonly known as "coqui 8 frogs"; 9 Wasmannia auropunctata, commonly known as "little fire (2) 10 ants"; 11 (3) Hypothenemus hampei, commonly known as "coffee borer 12 beetles" or "coffee berry borers"; 13 (4)Dynastinae, commonly known as "rhinoceros beetles"; 14 and 15 (5) Angiostrongylus cantonensis, commonly known as "rat 16 lungworm disease."
