# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the definition of
 the practice of medicine was last amended in 2008 by including a
 distinct definition of osteopathic medicine. The legislature
 further finds that medical doctors and osteopathic doctors are
 both physicians of equivalent education and training and should
 be regulated as such.

7 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish a
8 definition of the practice of medicine that provides uniformity
9 of practice for both medical and osteopathic physicians.

10 SECTION 2. Section 453-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 "§453-1 Practice of medicine defined. For the purposes of 13 this chapter the practice of medicine by a physician or an 14 osteopathic physician includes the use of drugs and medicines, 15 <u>surgery, manual medicine,</u> water, electricity, hypnotism, 16 <u>telehealth, the interpretation of tests, including primary</u>

17 diagnosis of pathology specimens, medical imaging, or any
