A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I of article 10A to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>\$431:10A-A</u> Coverage for auto-injectable epinephrine;
5	minors. (a) Each policy of individual accident and health or
6	sickness issued or renewed in this State after December 31,
7	2020, shall provide coverage for the cost of medically necessary
8	auto-injectable epinephrine for individuals covered under the
9	policy who are eighteen years of age or younger.
10	(b) Coverage required under this section may be subject to
11	deductibles, copayments, coinsurance, or annual or maximum
12	payment limits that are consistent with deductibles, copayments,
13	coinsurance, and annual or maximum payment limits applicable to
14	other similar coverage under the policy.
15	(c) Every insurer shall provide notice to its
16	policyholders regarding the coverage required by this section.
17	The notice shall be in writing and prominently positioned in any



1	literature or correspondence sent to policyholders and shall be
2	transmitted to policyholders within calendar year 2020 when
3	annual information is made available to policyholders, or in any

11	" <u>§431:10A-B</u> Coverage for auto-injectable epinephrine;
12	minors. (a) Each policy of group accident and health or
13	sickness issued or renewed in this State after December 31,
14	2020, shall provide coverage for the cost of medically necessary
15	auto-injectable epinephrine for individuals covered under the
16	policy who are eighteen years of age or younger.
17	(b) Coverage required under this section may be subject to
18	deductibles, copayments, coinsurance, or annual or maximum

15	minors. (a) Each individual and group hospital or medical
16	service plan contract issued or renewed in this State after
17	December 31, 2020, shall provide coverage for the cost of
18	medically necessary auto-injectable epinephrine for individuals
19	covered under the individual and group hospital or medical
20	service plan contract who are eighteen years of age or younger.



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1	(b) Coverage required under this section may be subject
2	to deductibles, copayments, coinsurance, or annual or maximum
3	payment limits that are consistent with deductibles, copayments,
4	coinsurance, and annual or maximum payment limits applicable to
5	other similar coverage under the individual and group hospital
6	or medical service plan contract.
7	(c) Every mutual benefit society shall provide notice to
8	its members regarding the coverage required by this section.
9	The notice shall be in writing and prominently positioned in any
10	literature or correspondence sent to members and shall be
11	transmitted to members within calendar year 2020 when annual
12	information is made available to members, or in any other
13	mailing to members, but in no case later than December 31,
14	2020."
15	SECTION 4. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	"§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
18	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
19	policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
20	January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
21	this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections

6	SECTION 5. The benefit to be provided by health
7	maintenance organizations corresponding to the benefit provided
8	under sections 431:10A-A and 431:10A-B, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
9	as contained in the amendment to section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised
10	Statutes, in section 4 of this Act, shall take effect for all
11	policies, contracts, plans, or agreements issued in the State
12	after December 31, 2020.
13	SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by sections
14	1 and 2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
15	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
16	the new sections in this Act.
17	SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
