BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8	auto-injectable epinephrine, based on appropriate weight-based
9	dosage, for individuals covered under the policy who are
10	eighteen years of age or younger.
11	(b) Coverage required under this section may be subject to
12	deductibles, copayments, coinsurance, or annual or maximum
13	payment limits that are consistent with deductibles, copayments,
14	coinsurance, and annual or maximum payment limits applicable to
15	other similar coverage under the policy.
16	(c) Every insurer shall provide notice to its

or medical service plan contract.							
(c) Every mutual benefit society shall provide notice to
