A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 "§201- Transportation energy transformation grant fund; 4 5 electric vehicles. (a) There is established within the state 6 treasury the transportation energy transformation grant fund, to 7 be administered and expended by the department, into which shall 8 be deposited: 9 Appropriations made by the legislature; (1) 10 (2) Gifts, grants, and other public and private funds; 11 Any federal funds; and (3)
- 12 (4) All interest and revenue of receipts derived from the
- fund.
- 14 (b) The moneys in the fund shall be used by the department
- 15 to:
- (1) Provide grants for the acquisition of electric
- vehicles;

1	(2)	Establish and fill two full-time equivalent positions
2		to carry out the purposes of this section; and
3	(3)	Pay for any administrative, operational, training, and
4		marketing costs associated with the transportation
5		energy transformation grant program.
6	<u>(c)</u>	A grant provided for the acquisition of an electric
7	vehicle s	hall be equal to twenty per cent of the actual cost of
8	the elect:	ric vehicle or \$4,500, whichever is less.
9	<u>(d)</u>	Applications for grants shall be made to the
10	departmen	t and shall be for the acquisition of one or more new
11	electric	vehicles licensed and intended for use on the State's
12	highways;	provided that the electric vehicles are:
13	(1)	Intended to be charged primarily by renewable energy
14		sources; or
15	(2)	Able to be integrated intelligently with the
16		electrical grid.
17	<u>(e)</u>	A grant may be made to an applicant only if the
18	applicant	has:
19	(1)	Met the specifications and requirements established by
20		the director for the grant program;

1	(2)	Filed a completed application form, as prescribed by	
2		the director, together with all supporting	
3		documentation required by the director;	
4	(3)	Completed the purchase or lease, licensing, and	
5		registration of one or more vehicles, prior to	
6		applying for one or more electric vehicle grants;	
7	(4)	Provided any other information deemed necessary by the	
8		director; and	
9	(5)	Met any additional requirements of the grant program	
10		as determined by the director.	
11	<u>(f)</u>	Disbursements from the transportation energy	
12	transformation grant fund shall not be subject to chapter 42F.		
13	<u>(g)</u>	The director shall include information on the	
14	transport	ation energy transformation grant fund, and statistical	
15	informati	on on program participation, in the department's annual	
16	report to	the governor and the legislature.	
17	(h)	The director may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to	
18	govern al	l aspects of the transportation energy transformation	
19	grant fun	d program.	
20	(i)	As used in this section:	

- 1 "Director" means the director of business, economic
- 2 development, and tourism.
- 3 "Electric vehicle" has the same meaning as contained in
- 4 Section 30D of the Internal Revenue Code for "new qualified
- 5 plug-in electric drive motor vehicle".
- 6 "Integrated intelligently with the electrical grid" means
- 7 that the demand of the electric vehicle for electricity from the
- 8 grid is controlled to enable reduction of the vehicle's
- 9 electrical demand on the grid during peak demand times and to
- 10 enable maximum use of renewable energy sources, baseload energy
- 11 sources, or renewable energy potentially available off peak that
- 12 would otherwise be curtailed."
- 13 SECTION 2. There are established within the department of
- 14 business, economic development, and tourism two full-time
- 15 equivalent (2.0 FTE) positions, exempt from chapters 76 and 89,
- 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to carry out the purposes of the
- 17 transportation energy transformation grant program.
- 18 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to be

- 1 deposited into the transportation energy transformation grant
- 2 fund.
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the transportation
- 4 energy transformation grant fund the sum of \$

or so

- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 6 the transportation energy transformation grant program.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 9 this Act.
- 10 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
