A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "S302A- Education research and development revolving
- 5 fund; established. There is established in the department an
- 6 education research and development revolving fund into which
- 7 shall be deposited all revenues from the commercial adoption of
- 8 any products and services developed by the department. Funds
- 9 deposited into the revolving fund may be expended by the
- 10 department to support the research and development of innovative
- 11 curriculum, instructional materials, and related technologies."
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 15 deposit into the education research and development revolving
- 16 fund.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the education
- 4 research and development revolving fund the sum of \$
- 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021
- 6 to support the research and development of innovative
- 7 curriculum, instructional materials, and related technologies.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
