## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that a cardiac care unit SECTION 1. 2 is needed in Hawai'i county, as county residents suffering from 3 heart problems or strokes are often airlifted to O'ahu or Maui to 4 receive critical medical care. An individual suffering from 5 cardiac complications must receive interventional care within 6 two hours in order to recover completely. However, an 7 evaluation and airlift from Hawai'i county to O'ahu or Maui can 8 take much longer than two hours, increasing the risk that the 9 patient may not fully recover.

10 The legislature further finds that while there are barriers 11 to offering interventional cardiology for heart attack treatment 12 to Hawai'i county residents, Hilo medical center has reduced many 13 of these barriers through the acquisition and installation of 14 cardiac imaging equipment and software, as well as establishing 15 cardiology clinic infrastructure designed for up to three 16 cardiologists and supporting providers. Because cardiac 17 interventions are complicated procedures, it is important that



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Hilo medical center receives support to expand its offering of
 interventional cardiology for heart attack treatment, and
 thereby continue to save lives and improve the quality of life
 for cardiac patients.

5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 6 Hawai'i health systems corporation to improve the health care 7 services related to cardiac care at Hilo medical center.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
11 fiscal year 2020-2021 for the Hawai'i health systems corporation
12 to improve the health care services at Hilo medical center;
13 provided that the funds shall be used for the following:

- 14 (1) Costs associated with recruiting and employing two
  15 additional cardiologists while they establish their
  16 invasive cardiology practice;
- 17 (2) Costs of support staff required to support the18 cardiology practice;
- 19 (3) Initial training of catheterization lab, intensive20 care unit, and radiology staff;



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1	(4)	Purchasing of inventory of medical devices and
2		medications used for interventional cardiology
3		procedures;
4	(5)	Purchasing of medical equipment for the cardiac
5		catheterization lab and intensive care unit;
6	(6)	Purchasing of diagnostic laboratory equipment; and
7	(7)	Initial costs of a certified lab technician.
8	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaiʻi health
9	systems c	orporation for the purposes of this Act.
10	SECT	TON 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
