## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARINE DEBRIS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that marine debris, such
2	as derelict fishing gear including nets, lines, and ropes, is
3	often discarded into the ocean either with intent or negligence.
4	This debris is a pollutant to the environment and efforts to
5	dispose of it properly should be a priority.
6	The legislature further finds that the crews aboard vessels
7	should be encouraged to remove debris from the ocean, and could
8	accomplish this through a partnership between the State and
9	owners, lessees, crews, or other occupants of vessels, whereby

14	pound of	eligible marine debris delivered to a marine debris	
15	collectio	on center approved by the department. The program shall	
16	commence	on January 1, 2021, and end no later than December 31,

18	SECT	TION 3. There is appropriated out of the general	
19	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
20	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for	
21	implement	ing a pilot program pursuant to section 2 of this Act.
