BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 342L-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	The advisory committee shall study issues related to
4	leaks of	field-constructed underground fuel storage tanks at the
5	Red Hill	Bulk Fuel Storage Facility, Kuahua Peninsula, Pacific
6	Missile R	ange Facility Barking Sands, Hickam Pol Annex, and
7	Schofield	Barracks Military Reservation. The advisory committee
8	shall meet at least twice a year and consider:	
9	(1)	The short- and long-term effects of leaks of the fuel
10		tanks, including effects relating to the health of
11		residents, safe drinking water, and the environment;
12	(2)	Response strategies to mitigate the effects of leaks
13		from fuel tanks;
14	(3)	Methods to improve communication between the United
15		States Navy, Air Force, and Army; the State; any local

board of water supply; and the public in the event of

a leak of any fuel tank;

1	(4)	Groundwater test results in relation to the
2		surrounding areas of fuel tank facilities, with a
3		particular emphasis on the groundwater near the Red
4		Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility;
5	(5)	The implications of shutting down any fuel tank

7	(6)	Updates on progress toward meeting goals of agreement
8		between the State, the affected county, and the
9		federal government."
