A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEMENTIA TRAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as part of addressing the present and continuing "silver tsunami" in 2 Hawaii, first responders and investigators from the department 3 4 of human services' adult protective services program should be adequately trained to identify and interact appropriately with 5 individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. 6 7 Because individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related 8 dementias may not respond in a manner typically anticipated by 9 first responders and investigators from adult protective 10 services, providing dementia training designed to help identify, 11 interact with, and intervene in cases of suspected abuse or 12 neglect of individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related 13 dementias will enable these employees to better carry out their 14 duties and responsibilities.

15 The purpose of this Act is to establish a task force to 16 make recommendations to the department of health and legislature 17 regarding the dementia training necessary to help first

(c) The task force shall submit a report of its findings 1 2 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the department of health and legislature no later than twenty days 3 4 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2021. 5 The members of the task force shall serve without (d) compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including 6 7 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties. 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 9
