A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:
4	"CHAPTER
5	STATE EMPLOYEE AIR TRAVEL CARBON OFFSET PROGRAM
6	§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:
7	"Agency" means an internal division of a branch of state
8	government, such as a department, division, branch, agency,
9	program, or office, and includes the judiciary and the office of
10	Hawaiian affairs.
11	"Canoe plants" means plant species originally brought to
12	Hawaii by ancient Polynesian peoples and shall be considered
13	native to Hawaii for the purposes of this chapter.
14	"Carbon offset" means a reduction in carbon dioxide or
15	other greenhouse gases in, or emitted into, the atmosphere that
16	is achieved by, or on behalf of, a person or entity to
17	compensate for emissions of greenhouse gases resulting from



another activity undertaken by such person or entity. A carbon
 offset may be accomplished by an action that reduces future
 greenhouse gas emissions or that removes greenhouse gases from
 the atmosphere.

5 "Department" means the department of land and natural 6 resources.

7 "Employee" means an employee of the State including all
8 permanent employees of the executive, judicial, and legislative
9 branches. The term also includes legislative session staff.

"Greenhouse gas" means any of the following gases: carbon
dioxide (CO₂), methane (CH₄), nitrous (N₂O), sulfur hexaflouride
(SF₆), hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs), and perfluorocarbons (PFCs).

13 S -2 State employee air travel carbon offset program. 14 The governor, president of the senate, speaker of the house (a) 15 of representatives, chief justice, and chairperson of the office 16 of Hawaiian affairs shall establish a policy for their 17 respective branches of state government that requires all 18 agencies to participate in a carbon offset program established 19 and administered by the department to offset carbon emissions 20 caused by air travel undertaken by an employee of an agency in 21 performance of the employee's official duties. The fee for an



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1 offset required for an employee trip, as determined by the 2 department under subsection (b), shall be paid to the department 3 by the agency whose employee made the trip. 4 The carbon offset program to be established and (b) 5 administered by the department pursuant to subsection (a) shall 6 include: 7 A procedure for determining the amount of carbon (1)8 dioxide emissions in metric tons that result from air 9 travel by a single airline passenger, based on the 10 average fuel consumption and corresponding carbon 11 dioxide emission per kilometer traveled for the 12 aircraft in which the single airline passenger 13 traveled, passenger capacity of the aircraft, and 14 distance traveled; Carbon dioxide-reducing projects to be implemented by 15 (2)16 or on behalf of the department to create offsets 17 required under this section, which may include, but 18 not be limited to, projects for the reforestation of 19 degraded areas of Hawaii by planting trees native to 20 Hawaii such as koa varieties, sandalwood varieties



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1		including Iliahi, Laauala, Wahieala, Aoa, Aahi, and
2		canoe plants;
3	(3)	A methodology to determine the:
4		(A) Amount in metric tons of carbon dioxide, or the
5		carbon dioxide equivalent of other greenhouse
6		gases, to be eliminated from future emissions or
7		to be absorbed from the atmosphere by offset
8		program projects; and
9		(B) Cost, including materials, labor, and
10		administrative costs, per unit metric ton of
11		carbon dioxide reduction;
12	(4)	A procedure, based on the information developed
13		through paragraphs (1) and (3), for calculating the
14		fee to be assessed to an agency for the amount of
15		carbon offset in metric tons that is equivalent to the
16		amount of carbon dioxide emissions attributable to a
17		specific airline trip by an employee of the agency;
18		and
19	(5)	A record system to track the allocation of carbon
20		emission reductions from offset program projects to
21		specific offset requests for employee trips and the

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remaining offset capacity of any project for future
 offset requests.

3 (c) Fees received by the department from state agencies 4 for the carbon offsets to be provided under this section for 5 employee air travel shall be used by the department to defray 6 the costs of the offset program projects implemented through the 7 carbon offset program.

8 (d) In administering the carbon offset program, the 9 department may contract with public or private entities to 10 implement offset program projects, such as the planting of 11 trees.

12 (e) The department may adopt rules, pursuant to chapter13 91, to effectuate the purposes of this chapter."

14 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
