### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUEO RESEARCH.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the pueo, or 2 Hawaiian short-eared owl, is an endemic subspecies of the shorteared owl known as the "bird of wisdom" that offers guidance and 3 4 protection. It also has a special place in Hawaii's culture and 5 is revered by the ancient Hawaiians as an 'aumakua, or ancestral 6 quardian for many Hawaiian families. Because of the cultural 7 significance and potential ecological benefits of the pueo, it 8 is important to conduct comprehensive studies on the pueo in 9 order to allow researchers to better identify preferred breeding 10 and foraging habitats and ensure the continued survivability of 11 the pueo in the State.

12 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 13 department of land and natural resources to conduct, in 14 collaboration with the University of Hawaii college of tropical 15 agriculture and human resources, a breeding ecology study and 16 foraging ecology study on the pueo statewide.
