## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The university of Hawaii Maui college's office
- 2 of international and regional partnerships connects students
- 3 from Maui with students abroad to develop meaningful
- 4 relationships in an increasingly globalized world. The
- 5 partnership offers study abroad opportunities in Canada, the
- 6 Czech Republic, Japan, South Korea, New Zealand, Okinawa, the
- 7 Philippines, Portugal, and Spain. Such programs help students
- 8 gain foreign language skills and cross-cultural competence. The
- 9 office of international and regional partnerships also works
- 10 with the non-profit foundation Sister Cities in the county of
- 11 Maui to promote economic and educational relationships between
- 12 the county of Maui and the world. The college's office of
- 13 international and regional partnerships estimates that
- 14 \$ is needed to allow eighteen to twenty students to
- 15 participate in these study abroad programs, based on past travel
- 16 costs.

- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 2 funds for the university of Hawaii Maui college's office of
- 3 international and regional partnerships to subsidize travel
- 4 expenses and tuition for students who wish to study abroad.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 8 study abroad programs offered by the university of Hawaii Maui
- 9 college's office of international and regional partnerships.
- 10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of
- 11 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
