A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§141-</u> Grant program; beginning farmer and rancher
5	start-up costs. (a) There is established in the department of
6	agriculture a grant program to assist beginning farmers and
7	ranchers in meeting the operating costs, including start-up and
8	organization costs, to start their farm or ranch operations.
9	(b) The program shall provide grants to qualified
10	applicants with the following terms and conditions:
11	(1) No grant shall be given unless the applicant has a
12	fifty per cent match of funds to start the farm or
13	ranch operation;
14	(2) The total amount of a grant to any one applicant or
15	organization shall not exceed \$15,000;
16	(3) The applicant shall be a beginning farmer or beginning
17	rancher;

1	(4)	The applicant shall have received all applicable
2		business and tax licenses and permits;
3	(5)	The applicant shall comply with all applicable federal
4		and state laws prohibiting discrimination against any
5		person on the basis of race, color, national origin,
6		religion, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation,
7		disability, or any other characteristic protected
8		under applicable federal or state law;
9	(6)	The grant shall not be used for the purposes of
10		entertainment; and
11	(7)	The qualified applicant and grant application shall
12		comply with other requirements as the department may
13		prescribe including, but not limited to, providing tax
14		returns, business licenses, financial records, and tax
15		clearances or compliance certificates and making
16		available to the department all records the applicant
17		may have relating to the grant, and shall allow state
18		agencies to monitor the applicant's compliance with
19		any and all grant conditions.
20	(c)	The department may adopt interim rules, which shall be
21	exempt fr	om chapter 91 and chapter 201M, to effectuate the

1	purposes of the program; provided that any interim rules shall		
2	only remain in effect until July 1, 2022, or until rules are		
3	adopted pursuant to chapter 91, whichever occurs sooner.		
4	(d) The grant applications shall be reviewed and approved		
5	by an administrative staff member of the department.		
6	(e) As used in this section, "beginning farmer" means a		
7	new farm enterprise or person who has not farmed commercially or		
8	has been farming for less than two years preceding the		
9	application by the enterprise or person.		
10	(f) As used in this section, "beginning rancher" means a		
11	new ranch enterprise or person who has not ranched commercially		
12	or has been ranching for less than two years preceding the		
13	application by the enterprise or person."		
14	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much		
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the		
17	development and administration of the beginning farmer and		
18	rancher grant program under this Act.		
19	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
20	agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 3. Any provision of this Act to the contrary notwithstanding, the appropriations authorized under this Act 2 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the 3 appropriation is made. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance 4 5 of the appropriation made in this Act as of the close of 6 business on June 30, 2022, shall lapse. 7 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
