A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE SNAIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's land snails
- 2 have a significant role in native ecosystems. Hawaii's land
- 3 snails act as fungivores that scrape fungus off of plants to
- 4 promote plant health, decompose decaying material for plant
- 5 nutrients, and are a major component of intact watershed forest
- 6 communities. These snails may also serve as a food source for
- 7 other native species. In Hawaiian culture, snails such as
- 8 kāhuli, pūpūkanioe, and pūpū kuahiwi have a significant role in
- 9 native songs, hula, chants, and are a symbol of romance and
- 10 omens. Furthermore, land snails are among the most threatened
- 11 of all animal groups in the world, with more recorded
- 12 extinctions than birds and mammals combined.
- The legislature further finds that pūpū kuahiwi (Laminella
- 14 sanguinea) is a snail endemic to Hawaii and, according to the
- 15 International Union for Conservation of Nature Red List,
- 16 critically endangered. This snail is one of only a few living
- 17 representatives of the Amastridae family, the only extant

- 1 endemic family remaining in Hawaii. The pūpū kuahiwi have a
- 2 zigzag color pattern, reminiscent of kīke'eke'e, a Hawaiian kapa
- 3 pattern. This endangered snail is important for the
- 4 preservation of native ecosystems and the Hawaiian culture.
- 5 The legislature finds that designating the pūpū kuahiwi as
- 6 the state snail will increase awareness of the imperiled status
- 7 and cultural and ecological relevance of all Hawaiian land
- 8 snails, preserve their cultural and ecological significance, and
- 9 encourage continued conservation of native Hawaiian
- 10 invertebrates.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to designate the pūpū kuahiwi as
- 12 the official state snail.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 14 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 "§5- State snail. Pūpū kuahiwi (laminella sanguinea) is
- 17 established and designated as the official snail of the State."
- 18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
