A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FUEL TANK ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 342L-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: The advisory committee shall study issues related to 3 "(a) 4 leaks of field-constructed underground fuel storage tanks at the 5 Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility, Kuahua Peninsula, Pacific 6 Missile Range Facility Barking Sands, Hickam Pol Annex, and 7 Schofield Barracks Military Reservation. The advisory committee 8 shall meet biannually, within the same calendar year and at 9 least six months apart, and the committee shall consider: 10 (1) The short- and long-term effects of leaks of the fuel 11 tanks, including effects relating to the health of 12 residents, safe drinking water, and the environment; 13 (2) Response strategies to mitigate the effects of leaks 14 from fuel tanks; 15 (3) Methods to improve communication between the United 16 States Navy, Air Force, and Army; the State; any local
