### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 341, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

4	"§341- Environmental council special fund; established.		
5	(a) There is created in the state treasury a special fund to be		
6	designated as the environmental council special fund into which		
7	shall be deposited the following moneys:		
8	(1) Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund;		
9	(2) All revenues from the environmental response, energy,		
10	and food security tax pursuant to section		
11	243-3.5(a)(5);		
12	(3) Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies,		
13	private persons, and private entities; and		
14	(4) Any interest earned on the balance of the special		
15	fund.		
16	(b) Moneys in the environmental council special fund shall		
17	be used for the functions pursuant to section 341-6."

1 Section 243-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 2. 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 3 In addition to any other taxes provided by law, "(a) 4 subject to the exemptions set forth in section 243-7, there is 5 hereby imposed a state environmental response, energy, and food 6 security tax on each barrel or fractional part of a barrel of 7 petroleum product sold by a distributor to any retail dealer or 8 end user of petroleum product, other than a refiner.
