A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL MEALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated			
3	and to read as follows:			
4	"§302A- Plant-based food and beverage program. (a) The			
5	department of education shall develop and implement a plant-			
6	based food and beverage program.			
7	(b) Subject to available funds, the plant-based food and			
8	beverage program shall award participating public schools up to			
9	\$ in quarterly allotments for providing meals that			
10	include a plant-based food option or plant-based milk option, or			
11	both, pursuant to this section.			
12	(c) Subject to available funds, the department may limit			
13	the total amount of awards provided to participating public			
14	schools pursuant to this section to a total of \$ per			
15	year.			
16	(d) Any public school applying to participate in the			
17	plant-based food and beverage program shall provide the			



1	department of education with documentation of the number of			
2	plant-based food options and plant-based milk options under the			
3	federal National School Lunch Program that the school served in			
4	the 2019-2020 school year. A public school that does not			
- 5	provide this documentation shall not be eligible for the plant-			
6	based food and beverage program.			
7	(e) The awards described in subsection (b) shall be			
8	awarded for plant-based food options and plant-based milk			
9	options that represent an increase from the number of plant-			
10	based food options or plant-based milk options served in the			
11	2019-2020 school year, as demonstrated by the documentation			
12	required pursuant to subsection (d).			
13	(f) Participation in the plant-based food and beverage			
14	program by a public school shall be voluntary. Awards for			
15	participating in the plant-based food and beverage program shall			
16	be in addition to any other state or federal funding or			
17	reimbursement received by participating public schools.			
18	(g) The department of education shall adopt rules pursuant			
19	to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to carry out the			
20	purposes of the plant-based food and beverage program, including			
21	but not limited to:

7	<u>"Pla</u>	nt-based food option" means a food that contains no		
8	animal products or byproducts, including meat, poultry, fish,			
9	dairy, or eggs, and that is recognized by the United States			
10	Department of Agriculture as a meat alternate for purposes of			
11	the federal National School Lunch Program.			
12	"Plant-based milk option" means a beverage that contains no			
13	animal pr	oducts or byproducts, including dairy, and that is		
14	recognize	d by the United States Department of Agriculture as a		
15	nondairy	fluid milk substitute for purposes of the federal		
16	National School Lunch Program."			
17	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
18	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
19	much ther	eof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for		
20	the depar	tment of education to develop and implement the plant-

based food and beverage program, including but not limited to 1 2 the following: Contracting with third parties for professional 3 (1) development training for school staff on serving, 4 including preparing, procuring, advertising, and 5 creating menus for, plant-based food options or plant-6 7 based milk options; Purchasing cafeteria equipment to prepare plant-based (2)8 9 food options or plant-based milk options, as needed; 10 and Providing technical assistance and student engagement 11 (3) and education on plant-based food options and plant-12 13 based milk options, including providing taste tests, recipe development, and culinary education. 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 15 16 education for the purposes of this Act. SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020. 18
