## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADDRESS CONFIDENTIALITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that on July 5, 2018,
- 2 Governor David Y. Ige signed into law Act 115, Session Laws of
- 3 Hawaii 2018, known as the Address Confidentiality Act. This law
- 4 provides survivors of domestic abuse, sexual offenses, or
- 5 stalking with a substitute address to be used by state and local
- 6 government agencies instead of their physical address.
- 7 substitute address may be used whenever an address is required
- 8 for public records. Mail is received at the substitute address
- 9 and forwarded to the survivor's actual address.
- 10 The legislature also finds that no moneys were allocated to
- 11 support the program, and without additional funding, the office
- 12 of the lieutenant governor's current budget is unable to absorb
- 13 the start-up and day-to-day operational cost of maintaining the
- 14 program. Currently, the office of the lieutenant governor is
- 15 preparing to implement the program, but unless necessary funding
- 16 is available, the office of the lieutenant governor will be
- 17 unable to carry out the program's objectives.



- 1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 2 funds for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position, operating
- 3 costs, and equipment to administer the address confidentiality
- 4 program pursuant to chapter 801G, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for one
- 8 full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position, operating costs, and
- 9 equipment to administer the address confidentiality program
- 10 pursuant to chapter 801G, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided that
- 11 \$60,000 of the moneys appropriated pursuant to this Act shall be
- 12 used to fund the salary of the one full-time equivalent (1.0
- 13 FTE) position.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
- 15 lieutenant governor for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
