### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 421I, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

14	amended by adding a new section to part VI to be appropriately
15	designated and to read as follows:
