A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ABANDONED VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that according to the 2 county mayors, the problem of derelict motor vehicles abandoned 3 on Hawaii's roads and highways has become an epidemic. 4 legislature recognizes that the high cost of motor vehicle 5 registration fees is a primary contributor to the abandonment of 6 motor vehicles in the State. The legislature believes that a 7 statewide redemption center program for motor vehicles will 8 prevent further abandonment of motor vehicles in the State. 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to: 10 (1)Establish a motor vehicle redemption program for motor 11 vehicles to be disposed of at motor vehicle redemption 12 centers in exchange for a refund; 13 (2) Impose a motor vehicle redemption fee on all motor 14 vehicles sold on or after July 1, 2020; and 15 (3) Establish a motor vehicle redemption special fund.

1	SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by		
2	adding a new chapter to title 17 to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"CHAPTER		
5	MOTOR VEHICLE REDEMPTION PROGRAM		
6	§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:		
7	"Dealer" has the same meaning as in section 437-1.1.		
8	"Department" means the department of transportation.		
9	"Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 249-1.		
10	"Redeemer" means a person, other than a dealer, who demands		
11	the refund value for a motor vehicle intended to be disposed of		
12	pursuant to this chapter.		
13	"Redemption center" means an operation that:		
14	(1) Accepts from consumers and provides the refund value		
15	for motor vehicles intended to be disposed of; and		
16	(2) Ensures that the motor vehicles are properly disposed		
17	of.		
18	§ -2 Motor vehicle redemption fee. (a) Every motor		
19	vehicle purchased in the State on or after July 1, 2020, shall		
20	be subject to a motor vehicle redemption fee to be computed		

- 1 according to the net weight of the motor vehicle at a rate of
- 2 ten cents per pound.
- 3 (b) At the time of purchase of a motor vehicle, the dealer
- 4 shall:
- 5 (1) Assess and collect the motor vehicle redemption fee;
- 6 and
- 7 (2) Pay the collected motor vehicle redemption fee to the
- 8 department.
- 9 (c) The department shall deposit all moneys collected
- 10 pursuant to this section into the motor vehicle redemption
- 11 special fund.
- 12 § -3 Motor vehicle redemption special fund. (a) There
- 13 is established a motor vehicle redemption special fund into
- 14 which shall be deposited motor vehicle redemption fees paid to
- 15 the department pursuant to section -2.
- 16 (b) Moneys in the special fund shall be expended by the
- 17 department to administer the motor vehicle redemption program.
- 18 § -4 Redemption of motor vehicles. Each redemption
- 19 center shall:

Ţ	(1)	Determine the refund value for the motor vehicle to h
2		redeemed according to the net weight of the motor
3		vehicle at a rate of ten cents per pound;
4	(2)	Pay to the redeemer the full refund value for the
5		redeemed motor vehicle; provided that the department
6		shall reimburse each redemption center from the motor
7		vehicle redemption special fund for all refund values
8		paid by the redemption center; and
9	(3)	If the applicable county has not contracted with the
10		redemption center to provide motor vehicle disposal
11		services pursuant to section -5, transport the
12		redeemed motor vehicle to the applicable county
13		disposal facility.
14	S	-5 Counties; disposal. Each county shall:
15	(1)	Provide motor vehicle disposal services; or
16	(2)	Contract, subject to chapter 103D, with one or more
17		entities, including dealers, to operate redemption
18		centers and provide motor vehicle disposal services,
19	on each i	sland in the county."
20	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
21	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 1 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to be2 deposited into the motor vehicle redemption special fund.
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the motor vehicle
- 4 redemption special fund the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for the
- 6 counties to comply with the new mandates imposed under this Act.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the counties for
- 8 the purposes of this Act, in the following amounts:
- 9 City and county of Honolulu \$
- 10 County of Hawaii \$
- 11 County of Kauai \$
- 12 County of Maui \$
- SECTION 5. The legislature finds that the appropriations
- 14 to the counties under sections 3 and 4 satisfies requirements
- 15 under article VIII, section 5, of the state constitution
- 16 regarding the sharing of costs for state-imposed mandates to the
- 17 counties.
- 18 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
