A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

SECTION 2. Act 5, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, section 3,
appropriated \$9,297,877 in special funds to the department of
accounting and general services, to fund payroll and operating
costs for the stadium authority.

8 To ensure a safe facility for the general public and to 9 ensure operating efficiencies, the stadium authority determined 10 that various unbudgeted expenses would need to be addressed in 11 order to properly and effectively continue to maintain a safe 12 facility for the general public.

Funding to address an annual structural assessment report (from biennial to annual), project-design costs to initiate repair and maintenance based on annual structural assessment report(s), contracts to ensure law enforcement presence at events, various expenses related to safe operating equipment,

FCC frequency compliant wireless microphones, perimeter wall
 padding, and various other items urgently needed.

3 The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
4 appropriation to provide funds for the stadium authority to
5 address the foregoing items.

6 SECTION 3. The sum of \$1,137,708 or so much thereof as may 7 be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 for payroll and other 8 current expenses shall be appropriated out of the stadium 9 special fund, to address the foregoing costs for the stadium 10 authority.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the stadium12 authority for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY.

PURPOSE: To make an emergency appropriation to increase the special fund ceiling for the Stadium Authority to address unbudgeted/ unexpected expenses related to conducting an engineering structural assessment, funds to address the design portion of the prioritized repair items(s), and repair and maintenance of the facility, as well as various unbudgeted operating items required to continue to operate the stadium facility in a safe, efficient, and compliant manner.

MEANS:

Not applicable.

JUSTIFICATION: The increase in special fund ceiling will provide the Stadium Authority with the ability to address the aforementioned unbudgeted items that are necessary to ensure a structurally safe facility, including an annual (revised from biennial) structural assessment report to monitor and ensure that the stadium facility continues to remain structurally safe; project-design money to expeditiously initiate work on areas identified as requiring timely repair and maintenance; and prior year special fund assessment carried over into current year due to the increase in revenue generated from major entertainment events in prior fiscal year. Ceiling is also required to address unbudgeted contracts, one of which seeks to increase special duty law enforcement participation at events, as well as address unbudgeted operating expenses necessary for the Authority to operate in an

efficient and effective manner (safe operating golf carts, FCC frequencycompliant field microphone equipment, perimeter field padding, sani-toilet rentals, etc.)

<u>Impact on the public:</u> This bill provides the ceiling required to address the essential items required to monitor, assess, and identify areas where repair and maintenance of the facility may be required, allow for project-design, as well as provide funds to support a contract that will increase law enforcement participation to provide a safe facility for the general public.
