- 1 SECTION 14. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 2 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 3 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 4 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 6 of this Act are severable.
- 7 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
