- 1 SECTION 14. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of
- 2 the appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business
- 3 on June 30, 2021, shall lapse; provided that any funds

- 9 SECTION 15. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 10 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 11 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 12 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 13 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 14 of this Act are severable.
