RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Section 291-31.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) No person shall knowingly operate, affix or cause to be affixed, display, or possess any lamp, reflector, or 4 illumination device that appears to be the color blue, or colors 5 6 blue and red, upon any motor vehicle, motorcycle, motor scooter, 7 bicycle, or moped except for: 8 (1) County law enforcement vehicles authorized and 9 approved by the chief of police of the county in which 10 the vehicle is operated; 11 (2) Department of public safety law enforcement vehicles 12 with blue and red lamps, reflectors, or illumination
 - (2) Department of public safety law enforcement vehicles with blue and red lamps, reflectors, or illumination devices authorized and approved by the director of public safety;
- 15 (3) Department of land and natural resources division of
 16 conservation and resources enforcement vehicles with
 17 blue and red lamps, reflectors, or illumination

- 4 SECTION 3. Section 291C-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 6 "(b) As used in this section, "emergency vehicle" means a
- 7 police or fire department vehicle, ocean safety vehicle,
- 8 emergency medical services vehicle, freeway service patrol
- 9 vehicle, sheriff division vehicle, Hawaii emergency management
- 10 agency vehicle, county emergency management vehicle, civil
- 11 defense vehicle, department of transportation harbors division
- 12 vehicle, department of land and natural resources division of
- 13 conservation and resources enforcement vehicle, department of
- 14 the attorney general law enforcement vehicle, or a tow truck."
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun, before the effective date of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
