## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOUSING LOAN AND MORTGAGE PROGRAM.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the affordable
- 2 housing crisis continues to be one of the State's most
- 3 significant and challenging problems. As the cost of housing
- 4 increases, the State must continue to assist residents in
- 5 obtaining affordable rental housing.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to provide that assistance by
- 7 increasing the Hula Mae multifamily revenue bond authorization
- 8 from \$1,500,000,000.
- 9 SECTION 2. Act 291, Session Laws of Hawaii 1980, as
- 10 amended by Act 304, Session Laws of Hawaii 1996; Act 185,
- 11 Session Laws of Hawaii 2004; Acts 231 and 249, Session Laws of
- 12 Hawaii 2007; Act 121, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008; Act 138,
- 13 Session Laws of Hawaii 2012; Act 162, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 14 2014; and Act 175, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is amended by
- 15 amending section 11 to read as follows:
- 16 "SECTION 11. Issuance of revenue bond; amount authorized.
- 17 Revenue bonds may be issued by the Hawaii housing finance and



- 1 development corporation pursuant to part  $III[\tau]$  of chapter 39
- 2 and subpart A of part III of chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised
- 3 Statutes, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed
- 4 [\$1,500,000,000] \$ at such times and in such amounts
- 5 as the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation deems
- 6 advisable for the purpose of undertaking and maintaining any of
- 7 the housing loan programs under subpart A of part III of chapter
- 8 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to the funding or
- 9 purchasing of eligible project loans."
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
