A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 329-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending subsection (b) to read:
- 4 "(b) The designated state agency shall determine those
- 5 [schedules of controlled substances, classes of controlled
- 6 substances, and specific] controlled substances that are
- 7 purportedly being misused and abused in the State[-], and
- 8 identify opioid antagonists that are used to reverse the effects
- 9 of opioid overdoses. As part of the controlled substance
- 10 registration process, all practitioners, except veterinarians,
- 11 and pharmacies shall be registered with the department to
- 12 utilize the electronic prescription accountability system. No
- 13 identified controlled substances [may] or pharmacist-prescribed
- 14 opioid antagonists shall be dispensed unless information
- 15 relevant to the dispensation of the substance or pharmacist-
- 16 prescribed opioid antagonist is reported electronically or by
- 17 means indicated by the designated state agency to the central



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- 1 repository established under section 329-102, in accordance with
- 2 rules adopted by the department."
- 3 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:
- 4 "(d) Under the system:
- 5 (1) Information shall be reported in numerical format, not
- 6 less than once every seven days, on the filling of
- 7 prescriptions for designated controlled substances,
- 8 the dispensing of pharmacist-prescribed opioid
- 9 antagonists, and the dispensing of drug samples by a
- 10 licensed practitioner; and
- 11 (2) Each dispenser shall maintain a record of such filled
- 12 prescriptions, including all information described in
- subsection (c), for a period of five years. Each
- 14 dispenser shall keep these records available for
- inspection and copying by the designated state
- 16 agency."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
