BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	<u>\$706-</u> Extended terms of imprisonment for offenses
5	committed on agricultural lands. (1) The court shall sentence
6	a person who commits a crime on agricultural land to an extended
7	term of imprisonment if the person knew or reasonably should
8	have known that the crime was committed on agricultural land.
9	(2) The extended term of imprisonment shall have a maximum
10	length of imprisonment as follows:
11	(a) For murder in the second degreelife without the
12	possibility of parole;
13	(b) For a class A felonyindeterminate life term of
14	imprisonment;
15	(c) For a class B felonyindeterminate twenty-year term
16	of imprisonment;
