A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness is a
- 2 significant issue throughout the State. However, urban Honolulu
- 3 receives most of the moneys allocated to address the
- 4 homelessness issue. The legislature also finds that the State
- 5 is failing to collaborate with various local nonprofit
- 6 organizations throughout the State to address the homelessness
- 7 issue. The legislature believes that the severity of the
- 8 homelessness issue necessitates increased collaboration between
- 9 the State, counties, neighborhood boards, and nonprofit
- 10 organizations.
- 11 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 12 governor's coordinator on homelessness to develop and implement
- 13 separate regional plans for various neighborhoods across the
- 14 State to coordinate the services and shelter facilities of
- 15 public agencies and nonprofit organizations to meet the concerns
- of impacted communities and needs of the homeless population.

Ţ	SECTION 2. Section 346-381.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"[+]§346-381.5[+] Governor's coordinator on homelessness.
4	(a) The governor shall appoint the governor's coordinator on
5	homelessness for the proper administration and enforcement of
6	this chapter without regard to chapter 76.
7	(b) The governor's coordinator on homelessness shall
8	develop and implement separate regional plans for various
9	neighborhoods across the State to coordinate the services and
10	shelter facilities of public agencies and nonprofit
11	organizations to meet the concerns of impacted communities and
12 .	needs of the homeless population."
13	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

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and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
