BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 39, Session Laws
- 2 of Hawaii 2017, provided the University of Hawaii with express
- 3 statutory authority to enable and facilitate the deployment of
- 4 university educational and instructional resources, university
- 5 managerial and fiscal resources, and university personnel to
- 6 promote the economic health and diversification of workforce
- 7 opportunities in the State through the commercialization of
- 8 inventions and discoveries generated by or at the University of
- 9 Hawaii. Act 39 also included a repeal date of June 30, 2021.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to remove the repeal date in
- 11 Act 39.
- 12 SECTION 2. Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is amended
- 13 by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- 14 "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017[7
- 15 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2021]."
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken.
