## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 39, Session Laws
- 2 of Hawaii 2017 (Act 39), provided the University of Hawaii with
- 3 express statutory authority to enable and facilitate the
- 4 deployment of university educational and instructional
- 5 resources, university managerial and fiscal resources, and
- 6 university personnel to promote the economic health and
- 7 diversification of workforce opportunities in the State through
- 8 the commercialization of inventions and discoveries generated by
- 9 or at the University of Hawaii. Act 39 also included a repeal
- 10 date of June 30, 2021.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to remove the repeal date in
- 12 Act 39.
- 13 SECTION 2. Act 39, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, is amended
- 14 by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017[7
- 16 and shall be repealed on June 30, 2021]."



- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 2, 2050.
