# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRINCE JONAH KUHIO KALANIANAOLE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that Prince Jonah  
2       Kuhio Kalanianaole led efforts to convince the United States  
3       Congress to pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920,  
4       under which the department of Hawaiian home lands was created.  
5       The legislature finds that as 2020 is the centennial anniversary  
6       for the drafting of the Act, it is appropriate to honor Prince  
7       Kuhio's legacy as the author of the Act.

8       The purpose of this Act is to require certain public  
9       buildings on Hawaiian home lands to display portraits of Prince  
10      Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole.

11      SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
12      by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
13      read as follows:

14      "§27-       Prince Kuhio; portraits; buildings. Any public  
15      building or structure that is:



1        (1) Located within                feet of a mass transit project  
2                that receives moneys from a surcharge on state tax  
3                established pursuant to section 46-16.8; and  
4        (2) Located on Hawaiian home lands,  
5 shall display a portrait of Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaʻole."

6        SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

7        SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
