A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRINCE JONAH KUHIO KALANIANAOLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that Prince Jonah
- 2 Kuhio Kalanianaole led efforts to convince the United States
- 3 Congress to pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920,
- 4 under which the department of Hawaiian home lands was created.
- 5 The legislature finds that as 2020 is the centennial anniversary
- 6 for the drafting of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920,
- 7 it is appropriate to honor Prince Kuhio's legacy as its author.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require certain public
- 9 buildings on Hawaiian home lands to display portraits of Prince
- 10 Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 12 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated
- 13 and to read as follows:
