BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 468E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§46</u>	8E- Provisional license. (a) The board shall
5	grant, up	on application and payment of proper fees, provisional
6	licensure	to an individual who:
7	(1)	Possesses at a minimum a master's degree in the area
8		of speech pathology from an educational institution
9		recognized by the board; and
10	(2)	Engages in clinical or academic practice under the
11		supervision of a licensed speech pathologist for such
12		period of time as needed to fulfill the necessary
13		requirements for licensure as a speech pathologist
14		pursuant to section 468E-5.
15	(b)	Each provisional license shall include the name and
16	title of	a speech pathologist who is licensed, possesses an
17	American	Speech-Language-Hearing Association certificate of

- 1 clinical competence, is in good standing, and will supervise the
- 2 provisional licensee. A provisional licensee may practice
- 3 speech pathology only under the supervision of the licensed
- 4 speech pathologist named on the provisional license.
- 5 (c) A provisional license shall be valid for one year from
- 6 the date of issuance and may be renewed for an additional one
- 7 year period if needed to fulfill the requirements for licensure
- 8 as a speech pathologist pursuant to section 468E-5."
- 9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 2019.
