BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2020.
- 3 SECTION 2. Act 38, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended
- 4 by amending part II to read as follows:

- 6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
- 7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
- 8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
- 9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
- 10 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total
- 11 expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions
- 12 established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not
- 13 exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
- 14 year, except as provided in this Act.
