# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2020.
- 3 SECTION 2. Act 38, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended
- 4 by amending part II to read as follows:
- 5 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS
- 6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
- 7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
- 8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
- 9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
- 10 beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. The total
- 11 expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions
- 12 established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not
- 13 exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each
- 14 year, except as provided in this Act.

- 3 "PART IV. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS
- 4 SECTION 8. The sum of [\$9,355,000] \$41,055,000
- 5 appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital
- 6 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
- 7 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
- 8 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
- 9 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; provided
- 10 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
- 11 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
- 12 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total
- 13 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of
- 14 dollars.

- 1 SECTION 4. Act 38, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended
- 2 by amending part V to read as follows:
- 3 "PART V. ISSUANCE OF BONDS
- 4 SECTION 9. General obligation bonds may be issued, as
- 5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to
- 6 finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part V of
- 7 this Act; provided that the sum of the general obligation bonds
- 8 so issued shall not exceed [\$9,355,000.] \$41,055,000."
- 9 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any
- 10 moneys from the appropriation for item 7.01 in section 8 of Act
- 11 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, as amended by Act 26, Session
- 12 Laws of Hawaii 2018, that are unallotted, unencumbered, or
- 13 unrequired as of the effective date of this Act shall lapse.
- 14 SECTION 6. If any portion of this Act or its application
- 15 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
- 16 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
- 17 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 18 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 19 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
- 20 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
- 21 extent possible.

- 1 SECTION 7. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
- 2 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
- 3 may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this
- 4 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular
- 5 session.
- 6 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
