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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$81,255,247 or so much  
thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021  
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-  
first senatorial district, as follows:

1. Waianae Coast Swimming Pool Project

# S.B. NO. 3093

1       SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
2 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date.

6       SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
