A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The seventh senatorial district encompasses the
islands of Moloka'i, Lāna'i, and Kaho'olawe, as well as Hāna, east
and upcountry Maui all the way to Kahului Airport. This is one
of the "canoe" districts; as such, each island area has vastly
different capital improvement project needs.

6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for capital7 improvement projects in the seventh senatorial district.

8 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue 9 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$118,154,700 or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof 11 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2020-2021 12 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh 13 senatorial district, as follows:
