A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are medicaid beneficiaries in the State with intellectual or developmental disabilities who are unable to access home- and community-based services. These individuals are at higher risk for future institutionalization because they may lack independent daily living skills and may be unable to manage their own care or to access the support necessary to maintain their independence.

8 The legislature further finds that establishing and 9 implementing a program for providing home- and community-based 10 services to at-risk individuals having intellectual or 11 developmental disabilities requires a thorough analysis to 12 ensure an appropriate continuum of care to these individuals.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to convene a working group to study the design and implementation of a program for providing home- and community-based services to individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities who
